


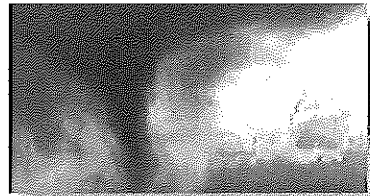
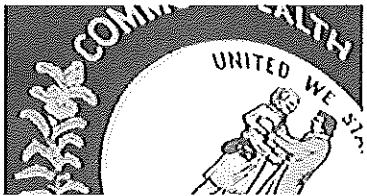
PROTECTION STATEMENT
